
HOW TO REPAIR SOLIDWORKS

If you have an issue with your SOLIDWORKS software and it may involve missing or problem software files, paths or registry entries, repairing your SOLIDWORKS may fix the problem.

1. Select the Windows Search Bar.




2. Search for Add or Remove Programs, then select Add or Remove Programs to open it.




3. Scroll down until you find the SOLIDWORKS installation version that you wish to repair (e.g., SOLIDWORKS 2025 Service Pack 0) then select the ellipsis for more options.




4. Select Modify.




5. Select Repair your installation, then click Next.



6. Select the products you wish to repair, then select Repair.



7. Wait for the repair to complete. This can take some time to complete.



8. When the repair is complete, you will be notified. Select OK.
